## Andrew W. Mason Joins Smith LaCien LLP in Chicago

Some of Mr. Mason's more recent and notable matters involve assisting Smith LaCien LLP's partners in obtaining a multi-million settlement for a plaintiff who suffered a traumatic brain injury after being thrown from his bicycle and succeeding in a declaratory judgment before the Indiana Court of Appeals requiring a large national insurance company to provide an injured plaintiff with up to \$1 million of additional underinsured motorist coverage.

While in law school, Mr. Mason was a judicial extern for the Honorable Eugene Wedoff at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois, was a summer associate at a commercial litigation firm in Chicago and helped start a highly profitable online and international wholesale business that collaborates with high-profile artists and celebrities. He has been an adjunct professor of law at Chicago-Kent College of Law since 2017.

A native of Riverwoods, Illinois, Mr. Mason received his Juris Doctor (JD) from the Tulane Law School in New Orleans, Louisiana in 2017; his Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the Freeman School of Business at Tulane University in 2014 and his Bachelor of Arts (BA), with a major in Public Policy and Law, from Trinity College in Hartford, Connecticut in 2008.
